Sun Safety

Hopefully the sun will stay with us until the end of term, so I thought it would be useful to remind you of our procedures:

- All children should have a **sun hat or cap** to wear when playing out. Ickleford School caps can be bought from Price & Buckland our school stockist @ £4.00 – baseball cap & £4.50 legionnaire cap. Please ensure all are NAMED clearly.
- You may wish to apply **sunscreen** to your child at the start of the day. However, children must not bring bottles of cream into school for reapplication. There are many brands which offer long-lasting/all-day protection and a liberal application in the morning should see them through the school day.
- Children should have a bottle of water with them in school each day which should be named.
- Children should have **summer PE kit** for outdoor sports every day (not long trousers).
