### ACCIDENT WAITING TO HAPPEN!

We are still getting complaints from our neighbours on The Green regarding irresponsible parking by some of our parents.

This has been reported to our local PCSO.

Please park away from school and not in front of driveways on Chambers Lane or on The Green. Our neighbours need 24hour access to their properties which includes school drop off and pick up times.

More seriously, parking on Chambers Lane on double yellow lines is putting our children at risk of having a serious injury due to poor visibility for them and drivers when attempting to cross the road.

## Sun Safety

Hopefully the sun will stay with us until the end of term, so I thought it would be useful to remind you of our procedures:

- All children should have a **sun hat or cap** to wear when playing out. Ickleford School caps can be bought from the school office if you want to priced £3.50. Please ensure all are NAMED clearly.
- You may wish to apply **sunscreen** to your child at the start of the day; however children must not bring bottles of cream into school for reapplication. There are many brands which offer long-lasting/all-day protection and a liberal application in the morning should see them through the school day.
- Children should have a bottle of water with them in school each day which should be named.
- Children should have **summer PE kit** for outdoor sports every day (not long trousers).
